

Made in England. 7kw Single or 3 Phase kiln.

Very little use by a glass artist and was only a hobby. It is in excellent condition and has always been very well looked after. Vacuumed after each firing.

Th FX range is for large capacity fusing and slumping. It is designed to be totally functional, simple and easy to maintain.

The heating system is in the roof from tubular heating elements. On the front and side of the kiln are large vent /peep holes to both allow a view of your glass and to assist with the cooling. The stainless-steel slatted roof allows for the kiln to cool much more easily.

It has a sturdy steel housing, including a stand with a shelf, and solid steel rolling base with locking swivelling wheels and a gas spring assisted lid for easy opening.

The insulation is excellent and makes the kiln ultra efficient and allows for a large capacity to be fired using very little electricity.

There is a multi-program controller, Stafford ST315A, is designed for glass or ceramics. Each section in the program has a heating/colling ramp followed by an optional soak.

There is a flat floor to allow for larger pieces to be carefully slid into position rather than lowering into place. This also allows for a clearer visual inspection of work before firing. Two inner shelves, 490 x 490 mm with posts are also included.

Glass of various thicknesses and other glass products can also be included.
